

CHURCH OF ST MARY THE VIRGIN, SAFFRON WALDEN, ESSEX

FEASIBILITY STUDY

St Mary's Saffron Walden is exploring the potential to adapt its building (a major Grade I listed church) and premises (Grade II listed cottage/Parish Rooms) to meet its current and anticipated future needs. The Church Council now seeks to commission a suitably qualified architect to carry out a feasibility study into how these needs might be met in a way which is compatible with the historic significance of the building and which will enable the mission and ministry of the church to flourish in the future.



St Mary's is the largest parish church in Essex. It is the only Anglican parish church within Saffron Walden and thus plays an important role in the spiritual and civic life of this historic market town of approximately 16,000 people.

Interested architects are invited to visit between 19 and 28 October by appointment, and to submit proposals for undertaking the feasibility study by Friday 25 November.
