Complete list of the 780 burials which took place inside the church accoding to the registers. The abbreviations in the third column refer to the part of the church where the burial took place. The three chancel locations are MC, NC, and SC (middle north and south chancels, corresponding to present choir, north chapel and choir vestry). Locations in the nave are referred to by their "alleys" or aisles i.e. MA (middle alley) NA (north alley) SA (south alley) CA (cross alley) UCA (upper cross alley) and LCA (lower cross alley). There was probably a clear "alley" between the south and north porches (latter now clergy vestry). V = Howard vault under east end of the church and Q = quire.
