THE MICHAEL SWINDLEHURST ORGAN SCHOLARSHIP

The organ scholarship, named after one of the SMMA's most loyal supporters was awarded for the first time in 2018. Designed to run for one or two years it will next be awarded in 2020. From late January 2020 full details and application information will be available on the Church website.

THE CHOIRS

The main function of the junior and senior choirs (both are mixed) is to lead the worship at St Mary's Church. However, in addition, occasional concerts are given, either in aid of a charity or music funds. There is currently a strong junior choir, while the senior choir numbers up to 50 of which up to 16 may be choral scholars. A Choral Scholarship scheme was established in March 2011 for teenage members wishing to develop and improve their musicianship. The choir is affiliated to the Royal School of Church Music, and all junior choir members have the opportunity to receive musical training following the RSCM ribbon awards scheme. From time to time we may hold a short waiting list of applicants wishing to join.
