Each year it is a different element of the Christmas story which seems to be particularly poignant. This year I am mindful of the growing expectancy of a struggling people: Knowing political, economic, and even spiritual loss and failure, the Jewish nation hoped and prayed for God to intervene.

And, God did, although not in anything like the way his people expected or wanted him to. At the heart of the Christmas story is a God who does not stand off and command from afar, or who is absent whilst his people struggle. God is born into his very people. becoming one of them and sharing in their struggle. The incarnation moves the locus of God out from the Holy of Holies and into the home, the pub, the marketplace, the ordinary. The incarnation does not mean that a single one of the world's problems simply disappears, but it does mean that in all the difficulties we face; as individuals, families, nations, and as the whole world; God is with us, and God is for us.
