Collect

Lord of creation, whose glory is around and within us: open our eyes to your wonders, that we may serve you with reverence and know your peace at our lives' end, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

First Reading: 2 Timothy 1 v 1-14

Psalm: 37 v 1-9

Second Reading: Habbakuk 1 v 1-4; 2 v 1-4

Gospel: Luke 17 v 5-10

The apostles said to the Lord, 'Increase our faith!' The Lord replied, 'If you had faith the size of a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, "Be uprooted and planted in the sea," and it would obey you.
